

REGISTRATION OF CONTRIBUTING EMPLOYERS REGULATIONS, 1975

(Under Sections 8 and 9 of the Order)

Date of commencement: 1st February, 1975.

Citation.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Registration of Contributing Employers Regulations, 1975.

Registration of contributing employers.

2. The employers specified in Column One of the First Schedule are hereby declared to be contributing employers, and shall register as such in the form prescribed in the Second Schedule within twenty-eight days of the dates for registration set out in Column Two of the First Schedule or on first becoming an employer of a class required to register after the said dates.

Liability of contributing employers for the payment of statutory contributions.

3. The dates specified in Column Three of the First Schedule are appointed as the dates upon which employers registrable pursuant to paragraph 2 of these regulations shall become contributing employers for the purposes of Part IV of the Order, and accordingly liable to pay into the Fund statutory contributions in respect of each of their eligible employees employed by them on or after the said dates.
